



### Pratt, Feika

I was born January 1, 1959 in Republic of Liberia. My parents are Mr. David Feika and Mrs. Hawa Pratt. I was born into a Muslim family. I am married and have six children.

At the age of nine years old I told my grandfather that I wanted to become a Christian because not all the family members should be Muslims. He accepted my request and sent me on the Catholic Mission in Sierra Leone where I spent fourteen years.
